18. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

19. MINUTES OF MEETING HELD 13th JULY 2020

RESOLVED: That the Minutes of the meeting held 13th July 2020 be approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

20. FORUM-QUESTIONS FROM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

In accordance with the Standing Orders members of the public were invited to ask questions or address the Parish Council.

No matters were raised.

21. MEMBERS' REPORTS

There had been complaints of loud music in gardens and this had been reported to PCSO N Jarvis. It had been recommended that details of times and dates be passed to the Environmental Health Officers at Cheshire East Council.

It was agreed that the grit bin on the Village Hall carpark be relocated to the opposite side.

Councillor S Clark reported on the overgrown hedges obstructing the path next to the School. This had previously been reported to Cheshire East Council and would be raised again. If the problem was not resolved the Parish Council would arrange to have the necessary work carried out.

22. VILLAGE HALL REPORT

Councillor M Pike reported Slimming World had made bookings of the Hall on Mondays and Wednesdays.

The fence had been sprayed and the PAT testing carried out. Work to remedy the damp and to the roof would be carried out shortly. The floor covering in the new room was on order.

Self-defence classes were being held on Saturdays and the Hall had been booked for a surgery with Dr K Mullen MP.

A quotation had been received for the work on the doors and this would be reported to the Management Committee.

23. HIGHWAYS GROUP REPORT

Councillor P Thomas reported that problems in accessing the data from the new SIDs had been resolved. It would be possible to rotate the SIDs to monitor vehicles from either direction and it had been noticed that most drivers were slowing in accordance with the signs.

24. WYBUNBURY WARD NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN.

Councillor M Pike reported on the Government White Paper on planning and the need for the Neighbourhood Plan to be regularly updated. Two recent applications had been refused citing the Plan.
